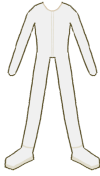
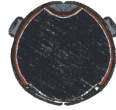


MY ARTEMIS ASTRONAUT



Underwear

Under the suit, astronauts wear long underwear that looks like pajamas! Because the Moon has no air or clouds to block out the Sun, the surface can get very hot when the Sun is shining on it. The underwear has tiny tubes of water that keep the astronaut cool while they work.



Helmet

An astronaut's helmet protects their head while on the moon. The Moon has no clouds to block out the Sun's light, so the visor is like one big pair of sunglasses! There is also no water on the Moon, so the helmet holds a bag of water for the astronauts to drink while they work.



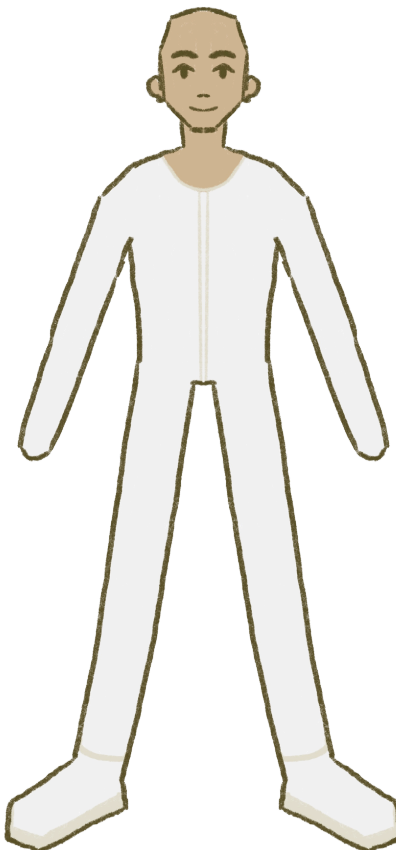
Suit Top

The top of the suit protects the astronaut's chest and arms. Strong layers keep them safe from tiny meteors flying through space, and also help cushion falls. The gloves protect astronauts' hands from sharp rocks while still letting them press buttons and collect Moon rocks.



Suit Bottom

The bottom of the space suit protects an astronaut's legs and feet. The bendy fabric lets them walk and leap in the Moon's low gravity. Special boots help the astronauts grip the dusty surface without slipping.



Life Support

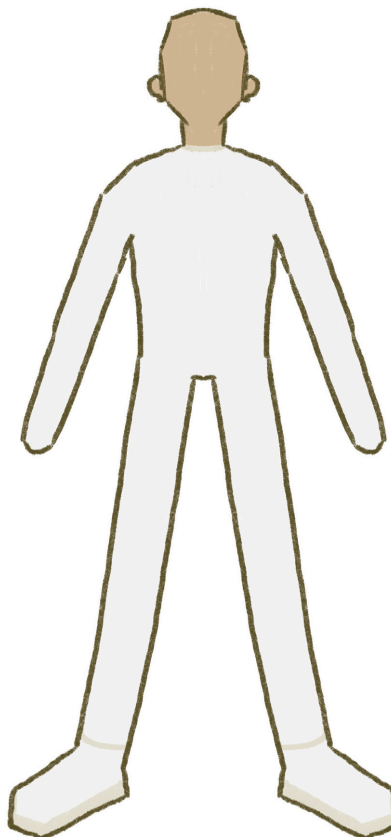
The moon does not have enough oxygen for astronauts to breathe. The life support pack holds a tank of air for the astronauts to breathe. With life support, astronauts can work on the Moon all day!

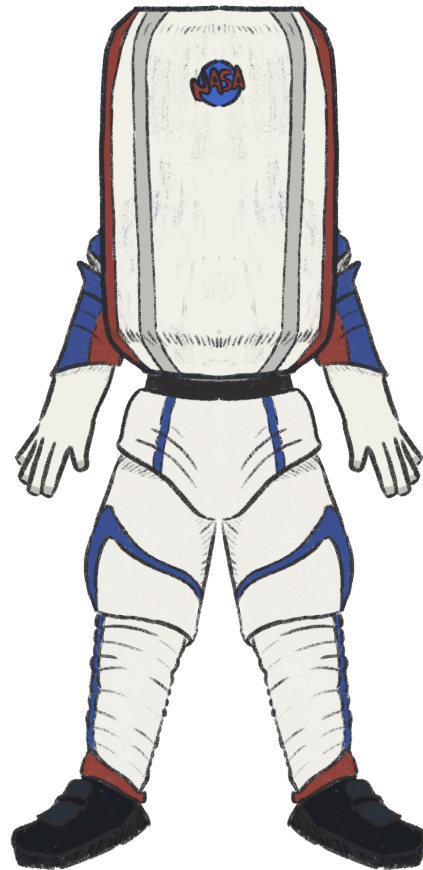


Suit Top
